What is AWANA?

Since 1950 AWANA has helped churches and parents worldwide raise children and youth to know, love and serve Christ! AWANA has fully integrated evangelism and discipleship programs for kids ages 2 to 18 that actively involve parents, church leaders and mentors. Each week, more than 4 million children and youth take part in AWANA in over 47,000 churches in more than 120 countries. AWANA is designed to have weekly clubs that appeal to churched and unchurched kids, lead them to trust Christ for salvation and help them grow in enduring faith and service to God.



Cubbies celebrates the spiritual potential of preschoolers (3- to 5-year olds) by helping them develop respect for God, His Son and His Word.

Books: Cubbies rotate yearly between Applesed and Honeycomb books.

Sparks is the AWANA program for boys and girls K-2nd grade.

FIVE COUNT

This is the method used in a group setting to get the attention of the entire group (clubbers, leaders and parents alike). When any leader counts to 5, everyone needs to be quiet, and come to attention, regardless of the activities going on.

DISCIPLINARY THREE COUNT

The 3-count is the method of individual discipline we use at AWANA. If improper behavior occurs, a clubber will receive a “1” from a leader and will have to miss game time. If the behavior problem continues the clubber will receive a “2” and will have to see the club director. If the clubber continues to misbehave, he/she will receive a “3” and will have to talk with the AWANA commander. Parents will be informed of the difficulties, and at the commander’s discretion, the clubber’s parents may be contacted to pick up the clubber early. If a parent can’t be reached the clubber will stay with the commander for the rest of the club time that night.
